

## 50 Ways to Support the Pick Kids Bond Issue

- 1. Host a twitter chat focused on the importance of the Pickerington Local Schools District Bond Issue
- 2. Host a live Instagram focused on the importance of the Pickerington Local Schools District Bond Issue
- 3. Follow the PLSD social media platforms and reshare its posts about the P4P Plan for Progress.
- 4. Share a link to the bond issue information on the district website on your social media platforms
- 5. Ask 15 of your Facebook friends to share <u>a link</u> to the bond issue information and website on their social media sites
- 6. Place a bond issue yard sign in your yard, take a picture and share via social media
- 7. Create a fun individual or family video about why you believe the bond issue is important to the district
- 8. Share ways that the Pickerington Local School district makes a difference to you and your children and post on your social media platforms:
  - a. Post a shout out to one of your student's teachers
  - b. Thank a school administrator
  - c. Thank bus driver, cafeteria or facilities personnel
  - d. Thank superintendent and administrators
- 9. Ask 15 of your friends to host a virtual party with their friends and family, visit the website and walk through the information about the bond issue to be informed (Bring your own food!)
- 10. Conduct virtual bond issue parties with your neighbors and ask them to do the same with 15 of their friends
- 11. Post about the bond issues and tag 15 friends and tell them to tag 15 friends, too
- 12. Post about the Bond issue and ask 15 friends to share it and tag 15 friends as well
- 13. Volunteer to help the VoteForPickKids committee
- 14. Text 15 friends a link to bond issue information on the website
- 15. Post about the Bond issue in 15 of your most active groups on social media
- 16. Send an email to 15 friends and family members about the bond issue and include a link to the website
- 17. Sit down with your family and make a list of 50 contacts that you can call to talk about the bond issue and ask them to do the same
- 18. Ask your organization or group for 5 minutes to talk about the bond issue in their meetings
- 19. Ask your favorite coffee shop or place of business to post info about the bond issue on their social media sites
- 20. Call 15 people you know and make sure they understand what the bond issue will provide for students
- 21. Text 15 people you know and make sure they have the link to the bond issue website
- 22. Remind your family members that the bond issue is on the November 3 ballot
- 23. Go to <a href="https://www.pickerington.k12.oh.us/about-the-nov-3-bond-issue/">https://www.pickerington.k12.oh.us/about-the-nov-3-bond-issue/</a> and download the Q&A about the bond issue

- 25. Post this information on your social media sites and ask 15 of your friends to do the same
  - a. We will construct a new junior high school to help alleviate overcrowding, as well as renovations and security updates throughout the district. Post this information on your social media sites and ask 15 of your friends to do the same

  - a. More classroom space, more extracurricular/common space and secure building entrances will ensure our schools can continue to serve students now and into the future. All buildings will receive renovations to either alleviate overcrowding, provide security updates, or both.
- 27. Post this information on your social media sites and ask 15 of your friends to do the same
  - a. The new junior high would be constructed on the approximately 66-acre parcel of land owned by the district on Lockville Road, south of Opportunity Way (adjacent to the Pickerington High School Central campus), while Ridgeview Junior High would be repurposed into a K-6 facility for Heritage Elementary and Gateway Elementary students
- 28. Share this video on your Facebook and ask people to learn more about the needs of the district and the bond issue. Ask 15 of your friends to do the same.

- 29. Add a link to the bond issue information in your signature line in your email to inform people about the bond issue
- 30. Volunteer at your organization to share information and updates about the PLSD bond issue

- 32. Hold your own social distancing mask up family back yard bond issue barbeque (follow COVID-19 regulations)
- 33. Host a drive- through parade in your neighborhood and remind people about the importance of bond issue
- 34. Create this text and share with 15 of your friends asking them to share with 15 of their friends
  - a. A 2.9 mill bond issue would provide funds to construct a new junior high school and add renovations and security updates in schools throughout the district.
- 35. Post this on your social sites and ask 15 of your friends to do the same
  - a. Pickerington's schools are at or near capacity and 1,000 more students are expected to enroll in the next few years. Passage of the bond issue will alleviate overcrowding.
- 36. When you are on other zoom meetings, on live town hall meetings, add in the chat room a reminder about the PLSD bond issue will help reduce crowding in our schools.
- 37. Ask your doctor's/dentist's office or other small business owners if you can send them one of the posts above to include in their social media and/or give them a flyer to include in their offices
- 38. Make the PLSD bond issue part of your regular topic of discussion. Help others understand the bond issue will do for the district.
- 39. Create a social media calendar for you and your friends to post PLSD bond issue facts once a week between now and November 3.
- 40. Use these hash tags when posting on social media
  - a. #2020P4P
  - b. #PLSDLearn&Grow
- 41. Download resources from the PLSD website to share in among your friends and neighbors.
- 42. Invite members of the PickForKids committee to speak at your social group or other meetings or to your staff

- 43. Create this text and share with 15 of your friends asking them to share with 15 of their friends

- 44. Create this and post on Instagram , share with 15 friends and ask them to do the same
